# OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This Lantern uses batteries that are not included with this package. Purchase the required batteries and install as outlined below.

# **Battery Installation & Replacement**

Turn the lantern upside down so the battery compartment is facing right-side up.

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- While holding the lantern main body, twist the bottom battery compartment counter clockwise about 1/8 of a turn and remove. Remove old batteries and dispose of them properly as outlined in the Safe Battery Disposal section in this manual
- Insert three (3) D cell batteries following the plus (+) or minus (-) diagrams as shown on the wall of each battery cavity (figure A).
- Align the battery compartment post with the cavity in the battery compartment (figure B). Push down on the battery compartment and rotate clockwise to lock it. The compartment cover will click when fully closed.

- While holding the lantern main body, twist the bottom battery compartment counter clockwise about 1/4 of a turn and remove.
- Remove the battery tray and old batteries. Dispose of batteries properly as outlined in the Safe Battery Disposal section in this manual.
- Insert four (4) AA cell batteries following the plus (+) or minus (-) diagrams as shown on the wall of the battery tray (figure C).
- Align the battery tray in the battery compartment so that the two arrows are pointing towards each other (> <), then slide tray down (figure D). Ensure tray is inserted so THIS SIDE UP text is showing.
- Push down on the battery compartment and rotate clockwise to lock it. The compartment cover will click when fully closed.

## **Powering ON the Lantern**

- · Press and hold POWER button for 3 seconds to turn lantern ON. The lantern will start in the LOW light setting.
- · Pressing the POWER button within 3 seconds will change the lantern to the following light settings:
- LOW (initial setting) | MEDIUM | HIGH | SOS BLINKING
- Repeatedly press POWER button within 3 seconds of any mode to cycle to the next desired setting.

### Powering OFF the Lantern

· Press the POWER button once after 3 seconds in any mode.

## Safe Battery Disposal

### Care and Maintenance
