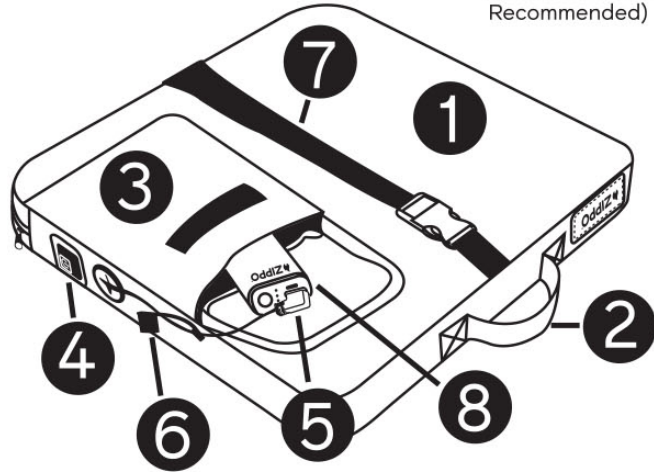

HEAT SETTINGS

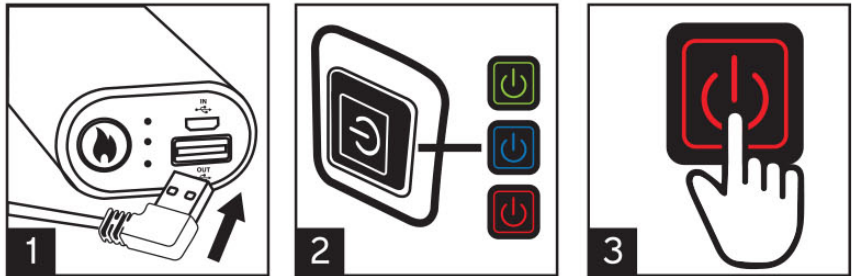
AS INDICATED ON THE SEAT CONTROL BUTTON:

- LOW= Green light
- MED= Blue light
- HIGH = Red light



POWER ON:

1. Plug the USB-A cable into a battery power source. (Zippo HeatBank recommended)
2. Once connected, the LED lights on the Seat Control Button will cycle through the 3 colors listed above.
3. Press and hold the Seat Control Button to turn on the Product. It will start in the HIGH heat setting (red light).



4. Each press of the Button will decrease the temperature one level and cycle thru the following settings:
A. RED Light High (initial setting) > MEDIUM > LOW
5. Repeatedly press Button to cycle to the next desired setting.
6. Place the battery power source into the pocket.



POWER OFF:

7. Press and hold Seat Control Button until the LED indicator light turns OFF.



PRODUCT WAKE UP:

8. If the Product has been plugged into a battery power source without using heating, you may need to wake up the Product by either:
 - A. PRESS and HOLD the Seat Control Button until the lights cycle thru the 3 LED indicator colors. or:
 - B. UNPLUG and PLUG back into your battery power source.

CLEANING:

 - Wipe clean with a damp cloth.
 - Do NOT submerge in water.
