





### FILLING THE PRODUCT

- 1. For best performance, we recommend

- . For safe filling: ensure proper mating
- Invert the fuel can and insert the tip of the butane into the Product Refill Valve.
- 8. Apply firm pressure to allow fuel to flow into the Product's fuel tank until full.


